Program Goal

This **six-week summer externship** immerses medical students in community-based research within underserved areas, preparing them to become **community-focused clinical trial researchers and advancing trial representation**.



Eligibility

Winn CIPP is open to active **1st-3rd year medical students** in MD, MD/PhD, DO, or DO/PhD programs at accredited U.S. medical schools (including Puerto Rico).

Participants must be U.S. citizens, permanent residents, or have DACA approval.
