Program Goal

This six-week summer externship immerses medical students in community-based research within underserved areas, preparing them to become community-focused clinical trial researchers and advancing trial representation.



Eligibility

Winn CIPP is open to active 1st-3rd year medical students in MD, MD/PhD, DO, or DO/PhD programs at accredited U.S. medical schools (including Puerto Rico).

Participants must be U.S. citizens, permanent residents, or have DACA approval.
